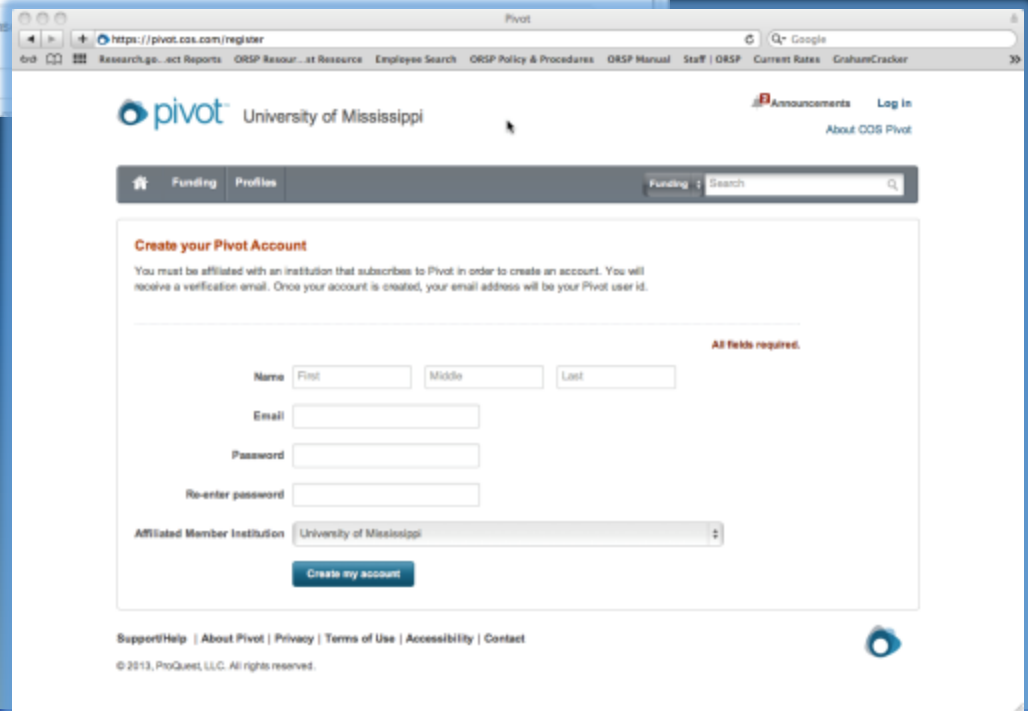
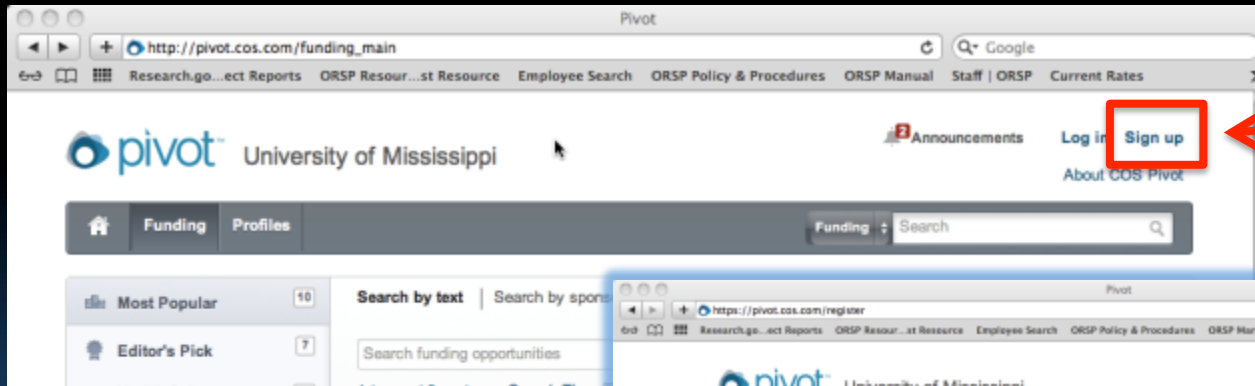

What is Pivot?

- Combines funding opportunities and scholarly profiles in one integrated package
- Suggests potential funding opportunities based on your Pivot profile
 - “harvested and maintained by Pivot editors”
- Search for Collaborators
 - Graze?



Example Search

Subject to search- “Education”

- Number of results?
✓ **10,550 !!**
- Sorting the results.
- Refining the search.
- Eligibility criteria to watch out for.
- Be a detective- Use your initial search results to develop your search “algorithm”



Example Search (cont.)

Keyword Index Search

Under “Advance Search” locate the Keyword index, and select ‘browse’.

- Open the Education folder.
- Select the folder “Education or Instructional Programs” followed by a sub-specialty.
- Do the search.
- Was that what you were looking for?
- **Pros and Cons of searching.**



Pivot Profiles: Overview

- Nearly 3 million profiles
- Global coverage – 75 countries, 2100 universities
- Over 200 disciplines represented
- Enriched with scholarly content
 - proprietary sources such as ProQuest and CSA , and
 - public sources including PubMed and the Researcher's website
- Editorial processes are applied to content for validation and accuracy
- Built and maintained by PIVOT editorial team**

What's In A Profile?

- Contact information: Name , addressees, email etc..
- Webpages : homepages, CV pages, and Publication pages
- Degree Information (institution, degree, discipline, year)
- Research Interests (key words)
- Academic departmental affiliations (includes role/position)
- Publication information: an automated proprietary matching algorithm
 - PubMed citation database
 - ProQuest citation databases
 - CSA citation databases
 - ERIC citation database
 - Agricola citation database



Who Is Included?

- Profiles are created for faculty members listed on University academic department websites.
 - Faculty profiles created based on the data available
 - Only updated every 12 to 18 months
- Claim your Profile – User created profiles
 - *Sign Up and create your account*
 - Update your profile, online in pivot or link to ORCID*



Quick Profile Search


1. Search box at top-right

(tab down for profiles)

- Enter search term (cancer)
- By default, search limited to UM
- Broaden search, use panel on left

- shows UM hierarchy
- view profiles to drill down by department

Example 1

- New Faculty member
 - 1) Interested in knowing who in the Med School is doing Dental related material sciences.
 - **Profiles > UMMC > School of Dent. > Dpt Bio Mat Sci > 8**
 - 2) Interested in knowing who is doing Microbiology on campus
 - **Profiles > Search Microbiology > refine with blue bar OR try limiting to just “expertise”**



Example 2

- PI looking for on-campus collaborators for specific announcement
- Areas of interest include
 - Biometrics
 - Intelligence and security
 - Security and Health
 - Security and Climate Change
- **How would you find Researchers with expertise in these areas?**
 - **Use the search bar with AND in caps**



Example 3

- Ralph E Powe Junior Faculty Enhancement Award
 - Oak Ridge Associated University (ORAU)
 - “Because of the close working relationship between ORAU and Oak Ridge National Lab, the *Award Committee particularly encourages collaborative interaction with ORNL.*”



Example 3 (cont.)

- Search by area of research, (Cancer; Breast Cancer)
 - choose “Outside Institutions”
- Refine Search by Affiliation
 - Oak Ridge National Laboratory



Example 4

- EPSCOR Track II proposals
 - Requires Collaboration between Jurisdictions
 - Search by area of research, (Photochemical)
 - choose “Outside Institutions”
 - Limit search by Country
 - United States > Louisiana
